Merciful God, let your peace overflow in Mary Humbert and family as they mourn the death of her mother.


Lord, help me to be a comfort to Mary

I gladly return, for your work, a portion of your abundant provision to me. All that I have is yours alone, entrusted Lord, to my care. Amen.




PM: The Lord bless you and keep you.
